- The HOD - IT presented the syllabus for professional core subjects of 5 th semester B.Tech Information Technology of Regulation 2021.
- 21IT5602 : Microprocessor and Micro controller, the panel enquired about the inclusion of exercise with arm microcontroller
- 21IT5603: Web Technology and its application, the panel suggested to include application and case studies of web in unit 5 and appropriate should be incorporated in COPO sheet.
